

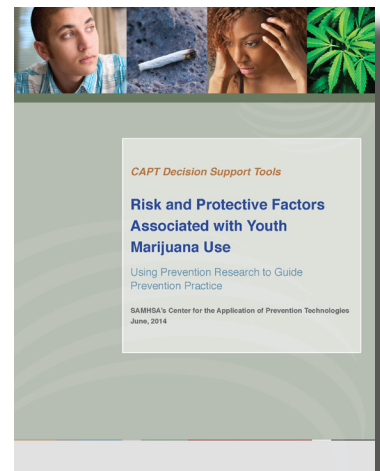
CAPT Decision-Support Tools

Preventing Youth Marijuana Use



SAMHSA's Center for the Application of Prevention Technologies (CAPT) has developed a selection of resources to support practitioners in preventing youth marijuana use. These are available to SAMHSA prevention grantees and the general prevention workforce on the CAPT area of the SAMHSA website—samhsa.gov/capt—in the Grantee Stories, Tools, and Other Resources section.

- ✓ **Risk and Protective Factors Associated with Youth Marijuana Use.** Provides a summary of research findings on risk and protective factors associated with marijuana use among youth.
- ✓ **Prevention Programs that Address Youth Marijuana Use: Using Prevention Research to Guide Prevention Practice.** Provides summaries of interventions that have been shown to prevent or reduce marijuana use among youth.
- ✓ **Strategies and Interventions to Prevent Youth Marijuana Use: An At-a-Glance Resource Tool.** Provides summaries of prevention strategies and interventions for reducing youth marijuana use at the state and community levels.
- ✓ **Preventing Youth Marijuana Use: An Annotated Bibliography, Using Prevention Research to Guide Prevention Practice.** This annotated bibliography contains article abstracts and recommended reading to help practitioners prevent youth marijuana use.
- ✓ **Youth Marijuana Use: Consumption, Consequence, and Risk and Protective Factor Data Resources.** Find data resources and surveys on youth marijuana use and risk and protective factors.
