

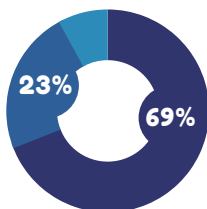

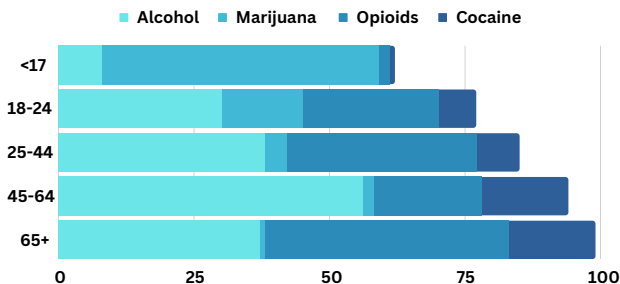


Admissions reported
